FMCSA: The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's primary mission is to prevent commercial motor vehicle-related fatalities and injuries. Activities of the Administration contribute to ensuring safety in motor carrier operations through strong enforcement of safety regulations; targeting high-risk carriers and commercial motor vehicle drivers; improving safety information systems and commercial motor vehicle technologies; strengthening commercial motor vehicle equipment and operating standards; and increasing safety awareness.

<u>Idaho State Police</u>: The Commercial Vehicle Safety Section (CVS) of the Idaho State Police works to increase safety on Idaho Highways. CVS officers work to enforce safety regulations as well as educate drivers and industry about commercial vehicle safety. There are currently 20 officers statewide in the CVS program.
